CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Conference Theme: “Nurses: Strategically Positioned to Move
Healthcare Forward”.

About the Conference

The Education Committee of the Caribbean Nurses Organization (CNO) 2024 conference cordially invites participants to submit abstracts either for oral presentation or for poster presentation.

The Caribbean Nurses Organization will focus on the strength, steadfastness, and innovative pathways to achieving a justifiable future for Nursing in the Caribbean through education, public health policy, research, leadership, and practice.

The five-day conference will provide an opportunity for a multi-disciplinary exchange of strategies that support nursing and prepare this discipline for success which will serve as a platform for the presentation and sharing of cross-sectional perspectives from professionals, academics, and administrators in nursing.

Sub-themes

CNO invites papers that take into consideration the conference theme and address the following sub-themes:

- **Nursing Education:** the evolution of nursing education in the Artificial Intelligence (AI) world.

- **Public Health:** The Role of the Public Health Nurse in the Battle of Infectious Disease, Climate Change and Post COVID-19 impact on healthcare Interventions.
- **Nursing Practice:** Technological innovation and the advancement of nursing practice.
- **Nursing Leadership:** Emerging roles of nurse leaders in healthcare, governance, policy, and quality management.
- **National Nursing Association:** Involvement in healthcare decision-making and politics.

Submission Details

Proposals for papers must include the following:

- Presentation title
- Presenter's Name(s) and Affiliation
- Sub-themes
- Abstract of no more than 300 words, which provide as much information as possible in these areas:
 - Key issues to be addressed.
 - Objective and scope of the presentation
 - Relevance of the presentation to the conference theme
 - Impact of the work and how participants can gain from the research/presentation.
 - Indicate the type of research: survey, case study, historical analysis, theoretical exposition, exploratory paper.

Final papers must be submitted in the following format:

- ❖ Language English
- ❖ Paper Length: A maximum of 2 pages (excluding published work & bibliography)
- ❖ Spacing: 1.5 lines at minimum
- ❖ Font: Times Roman, 12 points
- ❖ Margins: 2.5 justify
- ❖ Word Citation style: APA 7th Edition

Guidelines for Poster

- Poster size: 85cm wide x 60cm high 120cm wide x 85cm high
- Border: At least 5cm on all sides of the paper.
- Design/layout: Poster number and abstract should be placed on the top left Title, author and Institution should be placed at the top Body will be made up of the introduction, aim, objectives, method, results, tables, and figures.
- A conclusion should be placed at the bottom right-hand side.
- TEXT: Should be large enough for persons to see from 5-6 feet.
- Accepted abstracts will be in one of two categories: oral presentation and poster presentation. Please indicate your intended categories.

Deadline for Submission of Abstracts

- Deadline for submission of Abstracts: April 30, 2024
- Notification of acceptance of Abstracts: May 11, 2024
- Deadline for submission of final papers for presentation. May 31, 2024.
